Course: Sedona Golf Resort

1:00 Shotgun: *Starting hole is listed on your scorecard and cart sign*

Lunch: Provided to all participants before their round

Format: 2-Person Modified Scramble - Only parents will tee off on the following five designated holes and only kids will tee off on the following five designated holes. Competitors will scramble for the remainder of the hole. Both players will tee off on all holes not designated and select the best tee shot.

Scorecards: Exchange scorecards with your fellow competitors. Team score must be recorded on the card and signed by at least one player from the competitor group and one player from the marker group to be official. Scorecards should be returned to the scoreboard after completion of play.

Tees: All players will play from U.S. Kids Golf Tee Markers

Awards: Trophies will be presented to 1st and 2nd place in each age group

Tiebreaker: U.S. Kids Golf Scorecard Playoff will be used to break ties for all awards. Winner will be determined on the basis of the team score on the last nine holes, last six holes, last three holes and finally the last hole of the competition course. If the teams are still tied, continue backwards from the last hole until a winner is determined. (The "last nine holes, last six holes, etc." is considered to be 10-18, 13-18, etc.)

All team players will play from each chosen position.

Players' ball must remain in the same condition as the shot selected, i.e. fairway, rough, or sand.

Place your ball within 1 club length of the original ball no closer to the hole.

When on the putting green, place your ball within 6 inches of the original ball no closer to the hole.

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and by the following Local Rules:

- **Out of bounds** is defined by white stakes. Personal property lines shall determine out of bounds when a stake or line is absent. A ball coming to rest on or crossing a public road is considered out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the golf course.
- **Ball Unplayable** – One stroke penalty – Option a. play a ball as nearly as possible from the original ball was last played, Option b. drop a ball on a line behind where the ball lay keeping the point directly between the hole and the spot where the ball is dropped with no limit on how far behind the ball, Option c. drop a ball within two club lengths of the spot where the ball lay, but not closer to the hole.
- If you are in question of a ruling and can't reach a rules official immediately, please proceed under **rule 20.1C-3 and play a second ball**
- **Disqualifications** – No player will be disqualified for any violations of the Rules of Golf. Exceptions: a player maybe disqualified for a code of conduct violation.
- Distance measuring devices **are permissible**.
- **Pace of Play Policy:** Max 40 seconds to hit a shot. 15 minutes per hole is allotted to play each hole or a group may not finish behind the group in front of them more than 14 minutes. If a group falls **more than 2 holes** behind the group in front of them, they will be asked to skip one hole and take the maximum score of 10 for that hole.
